Vehicles must arrive before set up on Monday, October 19. Show management will confirm arrival window prior to the event. Any vehicle brought into the facility as part of a display must follow rules established per OHFC 314.4 Vehicles:

- Fuel tanks shall not exceed one (1) quarter tank of fuel or five (5) gallons, whichever is less. Fuel caps must have a lockable gas cap or be fully taped shut.
- The transfer of fuel is not allowed on GCCC premises. Contact the event manager if you need fuel transfer services.
- The battery must be disconnected, and cables must be taped together away from battery.
- Batteries in electric vehicles shall be rendered inoperable by the removal of fuses or other approved methods but are not required to be disconnected.
- If a display vehicle is approved to be displayed in a carpeted concourse area, carpet protection must be provided from the exhibit hall entrance to the concourse display.
- If a display vehicle is approved to be displayed in a tiled area, additional protection will be needed such as wood to be placed underneath the vehicle.
- If the vehicle will be displayed in a carpeted area or atrium, Visqueen (plastic) must be underneath the entire vehicle from bumper to bumper.
- Vehicle must be pushed once in the main concourse.
- Floor plans must indicate where vehicles are to be located and vehicles shall not be moved during show hours.

Display Vehicle Keys

The Columbus Fire Department requires that keys belonging to all approved display vehicles located inside the facility must be housed on-site with either the General Service Contractor or GCCC Public Safety staff with 24-access in case of emergency.

Vehicle keys provided to the GCCC at the time of display inspections and stored in a secured location until time of move-out. Vehicle owners must provide an emergency contact phone number for each vehicle. Vehicles required for exhibit set up event program must immediately be removed from the facility upon completion of event program tear down. If emergency personnel require the movement of a vehicle using specialized equipment, additional charges will be billed to the *Licensee*.
